BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION

In late 2009, Mr. Mogens Bach, representing the Tiburon Peninsula Foundation (TPF), approached the Town proposing to install two additional historical pedestals/plaques at two separate locations along the multi-use path (MUP). One would be located near the bus stop on Tiburon Blvd at Lyford Drive (in Caltrans right-of-way). The other would across from the Police Department on Tiburon Blvd (see Attachment 4-A).

The pedestals show graphics and/or vintage photographs of what the locations use to look like and brief descriptions of the history. Various similar historical pedestals can be found along the MUP.

The TPF will fund the majority of the installation and material through donations or their own funding. They are seeking a contribution from the Town. The TPF has completed all the necessary preliminary steps for their proposed project, including gathering all the necessary permits from the Town and Caltrans. They are prepared to start the work at any time.

Their proposal was discussed briefly during the January 6th Council meeting as a Town Manager’s report item. Their proposal is complete and staff feels the project is consistent with other features along the MUP.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the POST Commission review the proposal and recommend approval.
